Obligations

Cockram Corporation Pty Ltd (CC) is committed to ensuring that all its business operations are conducted in a manner that protects the health, safety and welfare of its employees, contractors, visitors and clients.

CC is committed to injury free workplaces through continuous safety improvement and aspires to a goal of zero harm to everyone involved in its operations.

Objectives

- Comply with safety legislation as a mandatory requirement
- Empower the workforce to behave safely and to positively act to ensure that their own safety is not compromised
- Provide written policies and procedures to ensure safe systems of work are developed, implemented and reviewed regularly
- Ensure that the CC Safety Management System and Project Plans are developed considering risk associated with the construction method
- Ensure that employees and contractors comply with OHS Policy, Procedures and controls as detailed in risk assessments or Safe Work Method Statements
- Facilitate a positive workplace safety culture led by the company's leaders and the active involvement of all CC management
- Monitor and audit OHS performance, share and communicate learning's from incidents and initiatives.
- Embed the STOP safety initiative across all CC operations

Responsibilities

Senior management will:

- Provide resources and systems to ensure that all CC workplaces are maintained in a safe condition
- Be Involved in the development, promotion and implementation of health and safety polices and procedures
- Ensure appropriate training of employees in the safe performance of their assigned tasks.
- Actively demonstrate their commitment to OHS excellence

Supervisors are responsible for:

- The health and safety of those employees and contractors who work under their direction.

Employees are to:

- Follow all health and safety policies and procedures
- Report all known or observed hazards to their immediate supervisor or manager
- Take all reasonable care and diligence to ensure the health and safety of themselves and any persons who may be affected by their acts or omissions at work

Application of the Policy

This policy is applicable to all CC building and construction operations throughout the world.

Consultation

CC is committed to open consultation and cooperation between management, employees, contractors and clients.

Review

This policy will be reviewed annually; communicated with staff and contractors; and posted on project notice boards.
